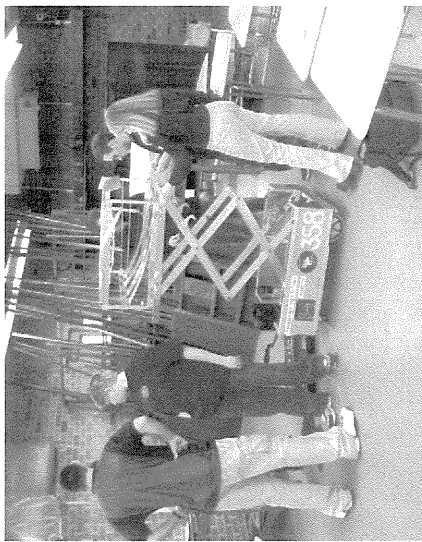


We learn Teamwork and Other Key Skills

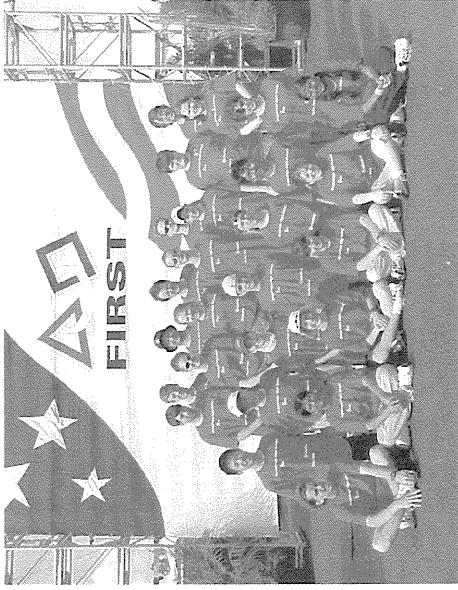

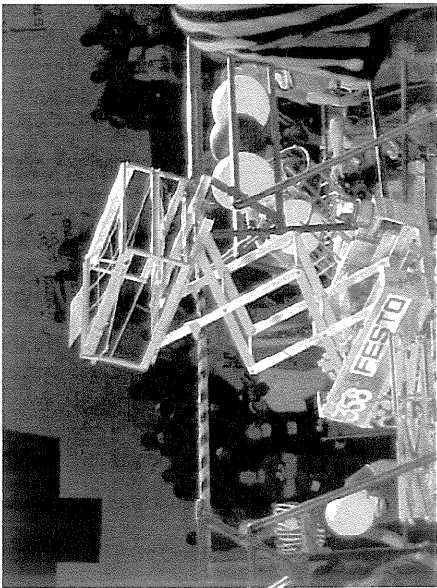
Go for the Gold in 2001!

Our Hauppauge High School "Titans" team participated for the first time in 2000.



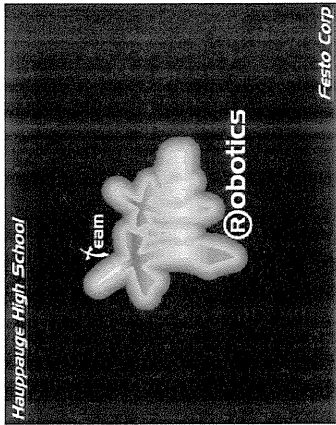

Then in March, we send our robot into action against robots from other local schools in a contest which judges each robot from the perspectives of design, functionality, innovative concept and teamwork.

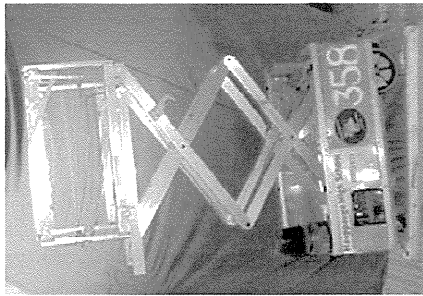
Hauppauge High School Titans Team

School and Community Pride and Support can help us strive to be a winning team in 2001.

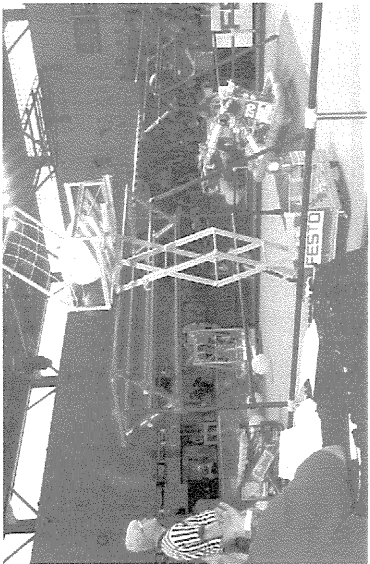


The Titans robot in last year's competition

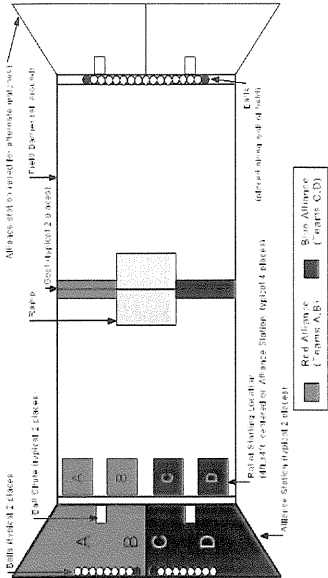


Our robot won the **Motorola Quality Award** for robust design in the 2000 competition.
