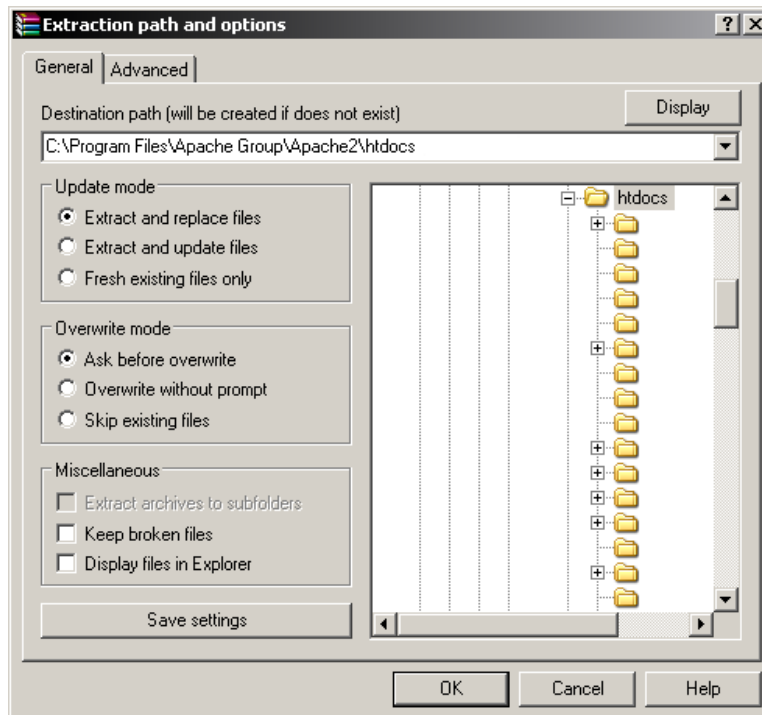

1. Download the latest phpMyAdmin English Zip file
 1. http://sourceforge.net/project/showfiles.php?group_id=23067
 2. [2.10.02 at the time of writing](#)
2. Extract to “*apache_root*/htdocs/”
 1. Rename the folder “phpMyAdmin-2.10.0.2-english” to “phpMyAdmin”



3. Setup
 1. Create a file in "*apache_root*/phpMyAdmin" called "config.inc.php"
 2. Save the following into the file:

```
<?php
$cfg['Servers'][$i]['user'] = 'root'; // MySQL user
$cfg['Servers'][$i]['password'] = 'mysql_password'; // MySQL password
?>
```
 1. Ensure to change the password
4. Test phpMyAdmin
 1. Run Apache2 web server
 1. If you left it running from before you must restart it

3. Open a web browser
 1. Browse to:
<http://localhost:8080/phpMyAdmin>
 2. If you see the phpMyAdmin main page, congratulations!
