BAE Systems, Inc. - FIRST Partnership:

BAE Systems will be providing grants to assist teams participating in the FIRST Robotics Program for the 2011/2012 season. In 2011, BAE Systems Inc. provided grants to more than 180 FRC teams. Through this grant program, BAE Systems wishes to encourage the recruitment, retention, and advancement of young people through FIRST.

Grant Program Policy:

BAE Systems provides grants to FIRST Robotics Teams that require financial assistance for registration fees, travel expenses, and general robot expenses.

In addition to the application questions listed below, teams will be awarded grants based on their commitment to the FIRST program, gracious professionalism portrayed during the season, and support and/or mentorship to FLL or FTC teams.

Any team awarded a BAE Systems grant must display the BAE Systems logo on their robot.

Final announcements of BAE Systems grants will be made by September 30, 2011.

Eligibility for BAE Systems Grants:

- Preference is given to teams that either participate in BAE Systems-sponsored events, have a historical affiliation with BAE Systems, are mentored by a BAE Systems employee or located near a BAE Systems facility.
- **The application deadline is Friday, September 9, 2011.** All applications must be submitted via email to bae.firstrobotics@baesystems.com. Hard copy applications will not be accepted.
